


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 20 million vaccines have been administered, with 59% of the target population completing the process.

Millions




Administered Doses per Age Group

Chile has received slightly more than 22 million vaccines thus far, with supply mainly coming from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.


COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending



Cases remain high, with close to 8,000 cases per day, and PCR test positivity rate is roughly at 10%.


COVID-19 Cases in Chile

PCR Test Positivity Rate




The rise in cases has been coupled with greater mobility restrictions; roughly 50% of the population is again under lockdown (Paso 1, area in red). Despite greater lockdowns, mobility continues to increase.

Critical bed capacity has increased steadily since Jan-21, yet remains stressed.



COVID-19 related Deaths


