



### An Update on COVID-19 in Chile


Almost 20 million vaccines have been administered, with 55% of the target population completing the process.







Cases remain high, with close to 8,000 cases per day, and PCR test positivity rate remains close to 10%.






Rise in cases has been coupled with greater mobility restrictions with roughly 50% of the population under lockdown (Paso 1, area in red). Despite greater lockdowns, mobility continues to increase.

Critical bed capacity has increased steadily since jan-21, yet remains stressed.




#### **COVID-19 related Deaths**


ICU patients above 50 years of age has increased at the margin, after falling for several weeks. The average age of ICU patients continues to fall.
