


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 50.0 million vaccines have been administered, with 91.3% of the target population completing the process (82.9% in the population under 18 years and 93.4% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being the country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 77 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 13.4 million booster doses have been administered. Chile has begun the 4th dose vaccination process, starting with the immunocompromised population, healthcare workers and people over 18 years old.



Chile has received more than 55.1 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending





During last weeks cases have been decreasing as well PCR test positivity rates. Although both indicators haave reached high levels, ICU occupancy levels, deaths and hospital capacity remain at moderate levels.



Currently, 62.1% of the national population is in Paso 4 (Step 4) and 37.3% of its population is in Paso 3 (Step 3).




ICU patients have increased, critical bed capacity has moderated.




COVID-19 related Deaths
