An Update on COVID-19 vaccinations in Chile

Santiago, April 5th, 2021. The Government of Chile is on track to reach its herd immunity target (15.2 million people) by the end of the first semester of 2021. Thus far, more than 6.9 million people have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. Separately, more than 3.8 million people have received a second dose.

Population Vaccinated

- As of April 1st, approximately 6.9 million have received the first dose of a vaccine, equivalent to approximately 45.0% of the target population.
- Roughly 3.8 million of the population has received the second dose, equivalent to 25.0% of the target population.

Vaccine Doses Received

- As of March 31st, Chile has received a total of 13,624,101 doses, composed of 11,971,476 SINOVA C doses and 1,652,625 Pfizer-BioNTech doses.
- Looking ahead, ~2 million SINOVA C doses are expected at a date yet to be confirmed, completing the agreed 14 million SINOVA C doses.
- A shipment of approximately 818,000 doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine is set to be delivered starting in May, as part of the COVAX Global Alliance contract.

Agreements with Suppliers

In addition to the previously confirmed agreements, the Government of Chile recently announced the purchase of 1.8 million doses of the mono-dose CanSino vaccine.

The Government of Chile has agreements with the following suppliers:

- SINOVA C: 14 million doses (double dose)
- Pfizer-BioNTech: 10 million doses (double dose)
- COVAX Global Alliance: 7.6 million doses (double dose)
- AstraZeneca: up to 4 million doses (double dose)
- Johnson & Johnson: up to 4 million doses (mono dose)
- CanSino: 1.8 million doses (mono dose)


In order to ensure the herd immunity target is met by the end of the first semester of 2021, the Government continues to negotiate the purchase of additional COVID-19 vaccines.

Progress on Administered Vaccines as of April 1st, 2021




Administered Vaccines (First Dose) by age Group & Gender




Daily COVID-19 vaccination doses administered per 100 people, as of April 1st, 2021
