An Update on COVID-19 vaccinations in Chile

Santiago, April 26th, 2021. The Government of Chile has made rapid progress in the COVID-19 vaccination effort. Thus far, more than 8.0 million people have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, equivalent to 49.9% of the target population. Separately, more than 6.2 million people have received a second dose, equivalent to over a third of the target population.

Vaccinated Population as of April 24th

- Approximately 8.0 million have received the first dose of a vaccine, equivalent to approximately 49.9% of the target population.
- Roughly 6.2 million people have received the second dose, equivalent to 38.8% of the target population.

Vaccine Doses Received

- As of April 25th, Chile has received a total of 15,984,501 doses, composed of 13,471,476 SINOVAC doses, 2,354,625 Pfizer-BioNTech doses and 158,400 AstraZeneca doses.
- The first shipment of AstraZeneca vaccines (158,400 doses) was delivered last week, as part of the 818,000 AstraZeneca doses of the COVAX Global Alliance.
- The first shipment of CanSino vaccines is expected to be delivered in May, and Pfizer-BioNTech doses will continue to be received regularly.

Agreements with Suppliers

The Government of Chile has agreements with the following suppliers:

- SINOVAC: 14.1 million doses (double dose)
- Pfizer-BioNTech: 10 million doses (double dose)
- COVAX Global Alliance: 7.6 million doses (double dose)
- AstraZeneca: up to 4 million doses (double dose)
- Johnson & Johnson: up to 4 million doses (mono dose)
- CanSino: 1.8 million doses (mono dose)

In order to ensure the herd immunity target is met by the end of the first semester of 2021, the Government continues to negotiate the purchase of additional COVID-19 vaccines.






Progress on Administered Vaccines as of April 24th, 2021

Administered Vaccines (First Dose) by age Group & Gender





Daily COVID-19 vaccination doses administered per 100 people, as of April 25th, 2021




